G.S.R. 389(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 57 of the Delhi Development Act, 1957 (61 of 1957) read with Sub-Rule 4 of the Delhi Development (Misc.) Rules, 1959 and in supersession of the Recruitment Regulations notified vide Notification No. F.7(121)2010/PB-I dt. 15.9.2011, the Delhi Development Authority hereby amends the Recruitment Regulation for the posts of Dy. Director (Revenue), Tehsildar, Naib Tehsildar, Kanoongo and Patwari of Revenue Cadre in DDA with the previous approval of the Central Government, as under:-
