Consequent upon the approval in 7th WAB Meeting held on 07.08.2018 under chairmanship of VC/DDA, minutes of meeting conveyed vide no. WAB1(76)/Vol.42/Secy./VII/2018/3374 dated 24.8.2018, the inspection limits of works by QAC are modified as under:

(iv)	All works to be inspected by QAC where TPQA has not been engaged (maximum two inspections for the works having tendered value up to Rs. 20 crores (**) and three inspections for the works having tendered value more than Rs. 20 crores (***).		

Note:-

No inspection by QAC where TPQA is engaged for the works below Rs. 10.0 (*):-

(**):- First Inspection at 30 to 40% of physical progress of work, Second Inspection at 70 t 80% of the physical progress of work.

(***):- First Inspection to be carried out at 15 to 20% of progress of work, Second Inspectio to be carried out at 50 to 55% of progress of work & Third Inspection at 75 to 85% physical progress of work.

The percentage of physical progress may vary in case if there is any specific reason. Note:-

Above limits are for routine inspections only. In case of complaint to QAC, Vigilance and a higher office work of any magnitude shall be inspected by the QAC, if it is fit case of inspection in t opinion of CE(QAC). Contd..Pug
