A total of 6715 properties were sealed so far. 2194 applications have been received for de-sealing properties. During the fortnight 1 property was sealed, 8 applications for de-sealing were received and 16 de-sealing cases have been approved by Monitoring Committee.

6. Regular Monitored Case: Removal of encroachment on govt. land by the owners of ground floor on the areas meant for Tot lots / parking / open space: Regarding the encroachment in pkt.1 Mayur Vihar Phase-I, as per the status report provided by EDMC dated 21.10.2020, all the brickworks and MS fencing have been completed in 54 tot lots. No reply has been received from medical officer, ESI to get the 2 tot lots clear. Some problems have been observed during fixation of wicket gates in 12 tot lots due to existing trees/ plants. Hort. Deptt of EDMC has been consulted to shift the trees / plants. The total work will be completed within a month.

13. Other issues

- NHRC case No. 5538/30/1/2019/UC dated 09.12.2019: The matter was discussed in 53rd meeting where it was decided to revisit the proposal.. As suggested in the meeting, the committee was reconstituted with 14 members. The meeting of the Committee was held on 21.10.2020, in which the issues highlighted in the report and suggestive measures were discussed. It was decided that the comments of the stakeholders are to be forwarded to Chief Town Planner, SDMC within 4 days to finalise the report. It was also decided in the meeting that the suggestions could be discussed in the first meeting of STF in the month of November.
- Additional Secretary, CVC vide D.O. letter no. 009/MCD/077-46215 dated 28.09.2020 to VC, DDA has forwarded the OM no. 019/MCD/031-458487 dated 27.08.2020 issued by Director-CVC. It has been informed that the reports on encroachment and unauthorized construction received from MCDs were discussed in the Commission and it has been desired that DDA may examine whether it is possible to establish a mechanism to have regular and surprise checks for encroachment and unauthorized construction.
- Regarding the complaint of Dinesh Chand Jain regarding encroachment of Govt DDA land of approximately 10000 square yards by the owner of Bhatia Acid Pvt Ltd. which was encroached by the said owner since last 70 years - matter would be taken up on priority
- The old ATR as seen on the web-portal is found to have increased to 7381. There is discrepancy in the data regarding the same, which is to be fixed by the Systems Department.
