1. Confirmation of the Minutes of the 52nd STF meeting held on 11.09.2020 circulated on 22.9.2020

One observation has been received from Addl. Commissioner(Eng), North MCD related to para 7F on removal of encroachment at Siraspur for which demolition programme was fixed on 23.9.2020. The observation is reproduced below.

'In the meeting it was discussed that this action is to be taken only as an interim measure till such time the issue is resolved for which a meeting will be convened under the Chairmanship of Vice Chairman, DDA along with all the stake holders i.e. Commissioners of DMCs, Secretary, PWD and District Magistrate, GNCTD. This aspect has not been mentioned. Further, it was also decided that the SDM will also be present during the action. It has been requested to consider the comments before finalising the 52nd meeting'.
