### SECRETARIES FOR DDA SPORTS COMPLEXES AND QUTAB GOLF COURSE

#### **For Sports Complexes**

- DDA has developed and runs 15 Sports Complexes in various parts of Delhi. DDA
  proposes to empanel persons in the following categories to manage these facilities as
  Secretaries:
  - Retired service officers of the rank of Lt. Colonel (or equivalent from Indian Navy
     / Air Force) and above with sports background and experience in running clubs /
     institutions of similar nature.
  - ii) Sports persons who have won Gold, Silver or Bronze medals (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> position) at senior level at State / National championship recognized by the affiliated Federation / Association for the sport and sports discipline in which the candidate had participated should be available at DDA sports complexes (name of sports disciplines attached at Annexure 'A'). Candidates applying in sports category should have atleast five years prior experience of working at administrative / managerial level in government /PSUs/ Autonomous bodies in the field of sports.
  - iii) Retired government servants, including DDA officers, who have retired in the grade pay of Rs. 7600/- and above (equivalent Level 12 and above of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC), which is equivalent to that of Directors and Suptdg. Engineers in DDA with proven credentials in sports or should have been involved in the development and maintenance of large international level sports arenas.
- 2. Monthly honorarium payable is as follows:-
  - (a) Secretary Divisional Level Sports Complex : Rs. 94,288/-
  - (b) Secretary District Level Sports Complex : Rs. 81,990/-
- 3. Travel allowance of Rs. 11,713/- per month would also be payable.
- 4. Honorarium and allowance would be enhanced by 10 per cent annually.
- 5. Applications are invited from persons not exceeding 60 years in category mentioned at para 1(i) and 63 years in categories mentioned at paras 1 (ii) & (iii) as on 31.12.2022 and residing in National Capital Region (NCR).

#### For Qutab Golf Course

- 1. DDA has developed Qutab Golf Course, Lado Sarai, New Delhi. Applications are invited for the post of Secretary of the golf course. Secretary of the golf course would be responsible for the operations, maintenance and management of the golf course.   - iii. Civilian candidates with 10 years experience in operations and management of golf courses.

- 3. Honorarium would be enhanced by 10 per cent annually.
