1. DDA is developing a championship level golf course at Sector-24, Dwarka, New Delhi. Applications are invited for the post of Secretary of the golf course. Secretary of the golf course would be responsible for the operations, maintenance and management of the golf course. Applications are invited from candidates in the following categories who have experience in operations and maintenance of golf courses:
 - i. Retired service officers of the rank of Lt. Colonel (or equivalent from Navy/Air Force) and above with experience in managing golf courses.
 - ii. Golf players of the following skill level:
 - a. Professional Golf Tour of India (PGTI) - A, B or C card holder on PGTI qualifying school with at least one top 30 finish in the season, or
 - b. IGU National Amateur Tour – Figured in the top 40 of the season ending IGU National Amateur circuit merit list with at least one top 10 finish in the season.

Candidates applying in this category should have at least 5 years prior experience of working at administrative/managerial level in government/PSU/autonomous bodies in the field of golf course operation, maintenance and management.
 - iii. Civilian candidates with 10 years experience in operations and management of golf courses.
2. Monthly consolidated honorarium payable to the Secretary is Rs. 1,59,720/-
3. Honorarium would be enhanced by 10 per cent annually.
4. Applications are invited from persons not exceeding 60 years in age as on 30.11.2021.
5. 6. Eligible applicants would be called for interview. No TA/DA would be payable for appearing in interview.
7. Selected candidates would be engaged purely on annual contract basis. Annual extensions of contract would be considered on the basis of performance. Contractual engagement can be terminated by giving 30 days notice by either party. Maximum tenure would be for 10 years or attaining the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier.
