"Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently pleased to pass the following order:"Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently submitted that, before the High Court, it was the specific case on behalf of the Delhi Development Authority [DDA]/Land Acquisition Collector[LAC] that the original writ petitioner had no locus. It is submitted that the aforesaid aspect has not been dealt with and/or considered at all. It is further submitted that it was also the case on behalf of the DDA/LAC, so stated in the counter affidavit, that the possession of the land in question was taken over from the landware however the case of the same was not

was taken over from the landowner, however, thereafter the same was not handed over to the beneficiary. It is submitted that the aforesaid 2 stand taken by the DDA/LAC has been construed by the High court as admission that the possession of the land in question was not taken over from the landowner.
