On 21 June 2026, Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Delhi, Sardar Taranjit Singh Sandhu, led DDA's 12th International Day of Yoga celebrations, organised across 29 sports complexes, parks and



public spaces throughout the National Capital. The large-scale event witnessed enthusiastic participation from thousands of citizens who joined yoga sessions across the city, reaffirming DDA's commitment to promoting health, wellness and active living.

The main Yoga programme was held at Yamuna Sports Complex, where the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor was joined by Hon'ble Union Minister of State Shri Harsh Malhotra. Shri N. Saravana Kumar, Vice Chairman, DDA, along with senior officers of DDA and other distinguished participants, also attended the programme, which witnessed enthusiastic participation from a large number of Yoga enthusiasts.

In line with the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, under whose leadership Yoga has evolved into a global movement promoting physical, mental and emotional well-being, DDA facilitated large-scale public participation in the celebrations across the National Capital. This year's theme, "Yoga for Healthy Ageing", underscores the vital role of Yoga in enhancing physical, mental and emotional well-being across all age groups and fostering healthy and active ageing.



DDA organised Yoga sessions at 29 venues across Delhi, including sports facilities namely Yamuna Sports Complex,, Siri Fort Sports Complex, Saket Sports Complex, Netaji Sports Complex (Jasola), Vasant Kunj Sports Complex, Hari Nagar Sports Complex, Paschim Vihar Sports Complex, Dwarka Sports Complex (Sector-11),



Major Dhyana Chand Sports Complex (Ashok Vihar), Rohini Sports Complex, Rashtriya Swabhimana Khel Parisar (Pitampura), Poorv Delhi Khel Parisar (Dilshad Garden), Chilla Sports Complex, Squash & Badminton Stadium (Siri Fort), Commonwealth Games Village Sports Complex, Dwarka Sports Complex (Sector-17), Roshanara Club and Bhalswa Golf Course.

Yoga sessions were also organised at several DDA parks and green spaces, including Baansera, Swarn Jayanti Park (Rohini), Coronation Park (Burari), Hauz Khas Park, Satya Park (Naraina Phase-II), District Park (G-17, Paschim Vihar), Ashoka Garden (Ashok Vihar, Phase-IV), DDA Park (GK-I), Vijay Mandal Park (Malviya Nagar) and Sanjay Lake Park (Trilokpuri).

The sessions comprised Yoga asanas, pranayama, breathing exercises, guided meditation and wellness activities conducted under the guidance of trained Yoga instructors deputed by the Ministry of Ayush, Government of India. People from all walks of life, including students, sports enthusiasts and members of local communities, actively participated in the programmes organised throughout the city.

With 18 sports complexes, 4 mini sports complexes, 3 golf courses and over 730 parks across Delhi, DDA continues to provide extensive infrastructure for fitness, recreation and wellness. Managing nearly 15% of Delhi's urban green area, including parks, biodiversity parks and the Yamuna floodplains, DDA plays a significant role in promoting environmental sustainability and community well-being across the National Capital.

The large-scale observance of the International Day of Yoga across DDA's sports complexes, parks and public spaces, including Baansera, reflects the Authority's commitment to advancing the vision of Fit India and encouraging residents and visitors alike to embrace healthier lifestyles. Delhi Development Authority (DDA) successfully concluded its **Mega e-Auction of land and property assets**, attracting robust participation from investors, institutions and businesses. Conducted through a transparent, technology-driven digital platform, the auction ensured fair competition, efficient price discovery and seamless participation through dedicated bidder support.

The auction comprised 142 residential, commercial, industrial, institutional and group housing plots, along with built-up commercial shops, multi-level parking facilities, kiosks and other licence-fee-based assets located across Delhi.

The strong response, particularly for strategically located properties in Karkardooma, reflects growing investor confidence in Delhi's development potential, strategic connectivity and future growth prospects.

DDA Accelerates Storm Water Drain Desilting Ahead of Monsoon

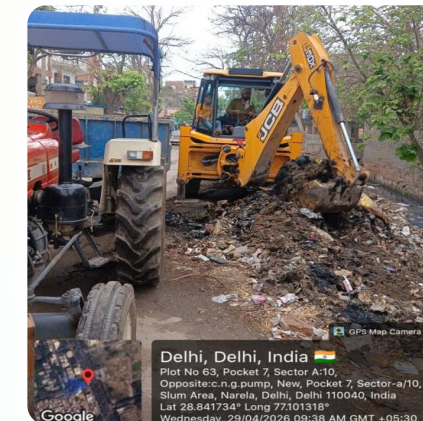


Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Delhi, Sardar Taranjit Singh Sandhu, who has been personally monitoring the desilting operations being undertaken by various agencies, especially the Delhi Development Authority (DDA), was informed that an extensive desilting drive of storm water drains under DDA's jurisdiction has been undertaken to ensure monsoon preparedness and minimize the risk of waterlogging across the city.

The desilting work was initiated well in advance as per the directions of Hon'ble LG, with the objective of ensuring smooth drainage of rainwater, preventing flooding of roads, reducing traffic congestion, maintaining hygiene, and improving the overall upkeep of public infrastructure during the monsoon season in the national capital.

As part of this drive, the DDA is carrying out desilting of 69 kilometres of storm water drains in Narela and 192 kilometres of storm water drains in Dwarka. The work involves removal of accumulated silt, debris, vegetation, and other obstructions that hinder the free flow of rainwater.

The desilting operations are progressing on a mission mode and approximately 70 percent of the work has already been completed. Hon'ble LG has directed that the remaining work is completed by 15 June 2026, before the onset of the monsoon.





Regular inspections and monitoring are being carried out by DDA officials to ensure timely completion and adherence to quality standards. The initiative is expected to significantly improve drainage efficiency, reduce instances of waterlogging, and facilitate smoother traffic movement during the rainy season.

Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor had earlier instructed that, to ensure that people in the national capital do not face water logging issue, the DDA must undertake a comprehensive desilting exercise in a mission mode.

The Delhi Development Authority remains committed to strengthening urban infrastructure and ensuring that all necessary measures are in place to provide a safe, clean and convenient environment for the residents of Delhi during the monsoon season.
