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Rural Development – 81 Projects Inaugurated Across Delhi Villages under Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan



Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi, Shri V.K. Saxena and Hon'ble Chief Minister inaugurate 81 developmental projects in 50 villages across Delhi.

Works include renovation of community halls, chaupals, roads, parks, and multipurpose centres, strengthening rural infrastructure.

Under DGA, 854 works worth ₹760 crore sanctioned so far, including 156 projects executed by DDA.

Initiative aims to enhance quality of life, civic amenities, and active community participation in Delhi villages.

To strengthen civic infrastructure and improve living standards in Delhi's villages, Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi, Shri V.K. Saxena, along with Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi, Smt Rekha Gupta, inaugurated 81 developmental projects under the Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan (DGA) On 24 Sep 2025, starting from Pooth Khurd, Rohini.

The projects span across five zones of Delhi:

- Dwarka Zone: 16 projects
- East Zone: 10 projects
- Narela Zone: 13 projects
- North Zone: 20 projects
- Rohini Zone: 22 projects





Hon'ble Minister, Delhi Government, Shri Ravindra Indraj Singh; Hon'ble MP, Shri Yogendra Chandolia; Hon'ble MLA and Chairman, Delhi Rural Development Board, Shri Rajkumar Chauhan; Chief Secretary, Delhi, Shri Dharmendra; and Vice Chairman, DDA, Shri N. Saravana Kumar were also present. As part of the Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan, these projects include:

- Renovation and upgradation of public buildings, chaupals, community halls, and multipurpose centres in villages such as Pooth Khurd, Bhalaswa, Holambi Khurd, Tiggipur, Ghoga, Sannoth, Bankner, Holambi Kalan, Narela, and Mohammadpur Majri.
- Development of open gym parks in Old Seemapuri and Karala.
- Improvement of roads, public spaces, street lighting, cremation grounds, and parks/playgrounds.
- Installation of CCTV surveillance and PNG connections, with the number of villages with PNG facilities now standing at 241.

Launched in December 2023, the Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan aims to enhance the quality of life in villages by identifying and addressing infrastructure gaps, providing essential civic amenities, and promoting community participation in local development decisions. To facilitate these projects, the Gram Sabha Area Fund of Rs.960 crore, previously unused, was transferred to DDA for execution.

So far, 854 works worth Rs.760 crore have been sanctioned under the Abhiyan, including 156 projects by DDA, reinforcing Delhi's commitment to inclusive rural development and equitable access to community assets.

Winter Sports Innovation - Foundation Stone Laid by Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi for India's First Government-Led Olympic-Size Ice Skating Rink in Dwarka

Facility to feature a 60m x 30m Olympic-size rink for Ice Skating, Ice Hockey, and Curling.

Modern amenities including Food & Beverage outlets, Rehabilitation Room, and Sports Shop to ensure world-class standards.

Facility aimed at recreation, training, and boosting India's participation in global winter sports.

On the eve of Sewa Diwas 16 Sep 2025, which coincides with Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi's birthday, Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi, Shri V.K. Saxena, laid the foundation stone of India's first government-led international-standard Ice Skating Rink at Sector-23, Dwarka. Once completed, this facility will open new avenues for winter sports in India, complementing the Fit India Movement by inspiring citizens to adopt active lifestyles.

Hon'ble MP, West Delhi, Smt. Kamaljeet Sehrawat, Hon'ble MLA, Matiala, Shri Sandeep Sehrawat, Vice Chairman DDA, Shri N. Saravana Kumar, and other senior DDA officials were present at the occasion. Planned as a landmark sporting avenue under the guidance of Hon'ble Lt. Governor, the Ice Skating Rink is being implemented by DDA on a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model. Upon commissioning, the facility will serve a dual purpose - strengthening Delhi-NCR's sports infrastructure while providing modern recreational opportunities for residents. The project, spread over 4,200 sqm in Sector-23, Dwarka, enjoys excellent connectivity via the Urban Extension Road (UER), Dwarka Expressway, and the airport tunnel linking Sector-21 with IGI Airport Terminal 3. The facility will feature an Olympic-size rink measuring 60m x 30m, capable of hosting Ice Skating, Ice Hockey, and Curling, along with world-class amenities such as Food & Beverage outlets, a Rehabilitation Room, and a Sports Shop. The project is slated for completion by May 2026. The project has been awarded on a license-fee basis for 15 years, with the selected agency responsible for construction and operation of the facility.



Currently, DDA manages 18 Sports Complexes, 4 Mini Sports Complexes, and 3 Golf Courses across Delhi. The upcoming Ice Skating Rink in Dwarka will further strengthen the city's sports infrastructure and support the sub-city's emergence as a model hub for sports, greenery, and modern urban living. Dwarka already hosts the country's longest 18-hole golf course in Sector-24 and the first Centre of Excellence in sports, with two more centers under development offering indoor and outdoor games for professional training and public recreation.

In addition, DDA's ongoing transformation of Dwarka includes housing schemes from affordable to premium, upgraded roads, modern community centers, efficient sewage

treatment systems, and the ambitious Bharat Vandana Park, spread over 200 acres. The park, blending heritage, ecology, and recreation, will feature Mini India, skywalks, water bodies, and leisure facilities, further reinforcing Dwarka as a sustainable and citizen-centric urban environment.



Knowledge Empowerment Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi Inaugurates Fourth Aarambh Library in Rohini



On Sewa Diwas, Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi, Shri V.K. Saxena inaugurates 'Aarambh' Library in Rohini, the fourth facility under the initiative within a year.

Open 24x7, the library accommodates over 130 students daily across three 8-hour shifts.

Equipped with modern facilities including high-speed Wi-Fi, modular study tables, secure lockers, CCTV surveillance, and a dedicated cafeteria. DDA to expand Aarambh Library network further, with an upcoming facility at Vikaspuri.

On the occasion of Sewa Diwas 17 Sep 2025, celebrated as the birthday of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi, Shri V.K. Saxena, inaugurated the fourth Aarambh Library at G-Block, Sector-11, Rohini. Developed within a year by the Delhi Development Authority, the facility provides students, especially in North-West Delhi, with an affordable and dedicated reading space to support their academic aspirations. Hon'ble MP, North West Delhi, Shri Yogender Chandolia was also present at the inauguration. Speaking on the occasion.

The Rohini Aarambh Library will operate round-the-clock in three 8-hour shifts, accommodating over 130 students per day at a nominal fee of ₹1,000 per shift.

The facility is equipped with:

- Modular study tables with integrated power sockets
- High-speed Wi-Fi and secure lockers
- CCTV surveillance for safety
- Comfortable seating in fully air-conditioned, well-lit interiors
- Separate washrooms for male and female students, including an accessible toilet
- 'Cafe Vardaan' for light meals and relaxation

The Aarambh initiative was launched in response to the tragic incident in Old Rajendra Nagar in July last year, which claimed the lives of three young aspirants due to unsafe study conditions.



Under the guidance of Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi, Shri V.K. Saxena, the first Aarambh Library was inaugurated in January 2025 at Old Rajendra Nagar, followed by Adhchini Village and Sector-16B, Dwarka.

The latest facility in Rohini reinforces DDA's commitment to safe, modern, and accessible study environments for students across Delhi.

With the Rohini library now operational and another facility planned at Vikaspuri, the Aarambh Library network continues to expand and strengthen Delhi's educational infrastructure, supporting the dreams of thousands of young learners.

Housing for All - Overwhelming Public Response to DDA's Apna Ghar Awaas Yojana 2025

Delhi Development Authority's (DDA) Apna Ghar Awaas Yojana 2025 received an overwhelming response from the public. Within just one hour of launch, all additional flats offered under the scheme were booked, marking a remarkable achievement and reflecting the growing public trust in DDA's housing initiatives. The sale expects to generate revenue worth Rs 100 crore.

As part of the scheme's expansion, DDA had offered 152 additional flats on a First Come, First Serve (FCFS) basis, including 76 MIG flats at Loknayakpuram (Block D) and 76 EWS flats at Narela (Sector A1-A4, Block G). Flats in Loknayakpuram (MIG) and Narela (EWS) have been offered multiple times since 2023 under various housing schemes. However, the recent rapid sale of these units stands as clear testimony to DDA's ambitious and progressive sales and marketing strategies implemented under the direct supervision of Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi, Shri V. K. Saxena.

Considering the continued high public demand for affordable housing, DDA has extended the Apna Ghar Awaas Yojana 2025 for an additional three months, now open till 26 November 2025. The scheme offers ready-to-move-in flats across multiple categories and locations including LIG, MIG, and HIG flats in Narela, as well as LIG flats in Loknayakpuram and Siraspur.

This extension ensures that more citizens have the opportunity to benefit from DDA's quality housing options. DDA remains committed to enhancing housing accessibility and simplifying home ownership through fully transparent and online processes.

In addition to its affordable housing efforts, DDA has also launched its Premium Housing Scheme 2025 on 26 August 2025, offering luxurious flats in prime locations such as Vasant Kunj, Alaknanda, Dwarka, Jasola, and Rohini. This initiative aims to cater to the diverse housing aspirations of Delhi's residents. The last date for online registration and EMD submission for participation in the e-auction process was 24 September 2025.

The facility offers air-conditioned spaces from 500 sq.ft to 4,000 sq.ft, accommodating up to 2,500 participants.

Hon'ble Lt. Governor has directed DDA to optimize the use of sports complexes and golf courses, ensuring both public access and revenue generation. Under his guidance, DDA has developed and dedicated several projects for Delhi residents, including:

- Centre of Excellence at Sector-8, Dwarka
- Country's longest 18-hole golf course at Sector-24, Dwarka
- Mini Sports Complex at Sukhdev Vihar
- Restoration of the century-old Roshanara Club

Delhi is also set to welcome its first international-standard Ice Skating Rink in Dwarka, Sector-23, and hot air balloon rides along the Yamuna, all under close monitoring to ensure timely execution and world-class quality standards.

From 25th to 26th September 2025, DDA hosted the Elevate India Fitness Conference, the first B2B event in the region dedicated to

the fitness and physical activity industry. The conference brought together sports therapists, strength and conditioning coaches, trainers, practice owners, and other fitness professionals, fostering discussions on physical literacy, entrepreneurship, and financial sustainability.

In the recent past, the Squash and Badminton Stadium has also hosted events such as Matrix Fight Night-16 (MFN-16), Delhi Open Fencing Championship 2025, and Delhi Open Pickle Ball Final, reinforcing its position as a key hub for sports and recreational activities in the capital. Currently, DDA manages 18 Sports Complexes, 4 Mini Sports Complexes, and 3 Golf Courses across Delhi. The upcoming Ice Skating Rink in Dwarka will further enhance the city's sports infrastructure, strengthening Delhi's position as a national hub for sports and fitness development.
